How many hours will I work?

We prefer volunteers to work a minimum of three hours. Shifts begin at 8.00 am and finish at 6.00 pm. You can work as many shifts as you like.

You will be required to attend a site induction 20 minutes before the beginning of your first shift, and breaks will be given between shifts. Volunteers will also be provided with a food/beverage voucher redeemable at our delicious Spudfest vendors.

The friendships, camaraderie, sense of community and shared laughter that come out of working at Spudfest will more than compensate for the time you give.
